### **How to make a SPARE CHANGE FOR CANINE CANCER collection jar**

Any kind of jar or can will do, but the easiest type to make uses an empty plastic cheese shaker.

1. Buy grated parmesan cheese in a plastic container with a flip-top lid.
2. Eat lots of spaghetti, liberally sprinkled with the parmesan.
3. Wash the empty container and remove the label.
4. Paste on a label, stickers, pictures or other decorations. Let the kids help!
5. Fill the container with spare change and donate it to the GRF Zeke Cancer Research Fund!

There are lots of places to collect change. Keep a jar in your car and drop in the change from fast food restaurants and tool booths. Keep a jar in your kitchen and empty your pockets and purse each night. Put a jar on your desk at work, or in the coffee break room. Take a jar to club meetings. Encourage your club to pass a jar around at dog shows and trials. Ask your veterinarian if you can put a jar in his or her office for a month. GRF will be happy to supply brochures to accompany your jar.

Your kids can learn about philanthropy with the spare change jar, too. Have them contribute to the family jar. Let them Trick-or-Treat for spare change, or collect change as a Christmas gift in honor of their beloved Golden. Older kids can organize their friends for a Work Day for Canine Cancer, raking leaves or washing windows, or hold the ever popular car wash. Remember all the band candy and Girl Scout cookies you've bought from your neighbors' kids over the years? It's pay-back time!
